The JU PPI seeks to play a leading and stewardship role in shaping the future of Florida and the nation. The Institute was established in 2012 as the first Institute of its kind in the state of Florida. It was founded on the notion that policy matters - that it shapes the future.

The heart of JU PPI is the two year, 48 credit Master in Public Policy (MPP) degree. The Institute offers an MPP degree and three dual degree programs: MPP-Marine Science, MPP-MBA, and MPP-Juris Doctor.
