**Join Us at a Summer Send Off Near You**

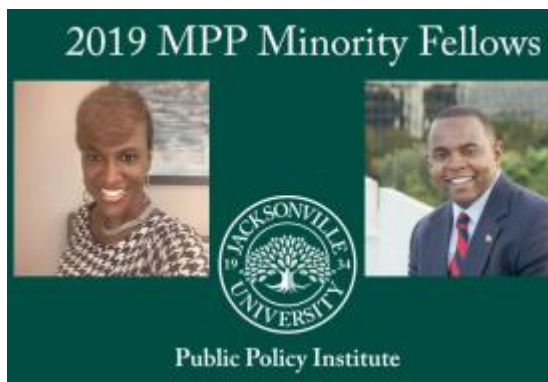
