## Jacksonville University Launches College of Law at Downtown Location

Jacksonville University announced plans today to establish a College of Law in downtown Jacksonville, supported by private funding and a \$5 million commitment of public investment from Jacksonville Mayor Lenny Curry.

Classes will begin in the Fall of 2022 with an expected inaugural class of 20-30 students, and a projected total enrollment of 150 students in Fall 2024.

## Jacksonville University to Launch Florida's First Certificate in Comprehensive Oral Implantology with M.S. in Dentistry

Recently, Jacksonville University announced a three-year Master of Science in Dentistry and Certificate in Comprehensive Oral Implantology.

The program, part of the university's Brooks Rehabilitation College of Healthcare Sciences, also offers the ability to earn an online master's degree from Jacksonville University while receiving instruction through a paid, in-person residency at one of several U.S. implant dentistry practices.

The first group of dental residents is expected to begin their training in the summer of 2022.
