Club Sport Program Requirements & Application Process

Below is a general overview of the requirements of new clubs in the Club Sport Program. Admission into the Club Sport Program at JU as a part of the Department of Campus Recreation is determined each year by the Assistant Director of Club & Intramural Sports, in conjunction with the Director of Campus Recreation & Wellness and the Club Sport Committee.

To be a member of the Club Sport Program, a student organization must meet all of the following guidelines:

- 1. Be a member or demonstrate potential membership in a national, regional, or state governing body, association, or otherwise sanctioned league for the sport.
- 2. Have a minimum of five (5) documented potential competitors, either through the governing body (sanctioned league) or clubs at nearby institutions (nearby is defined as within a 7-hour drive from campus).
- 3. Have suitable on-campus facilities in which the club can practice or train.
- 4. Identify goals of the club that demonstrate a common mission between the club and the Club Sport Program.
- 5. Have four (4) club sport executive officers (President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Safety Officer) willing to dedicate time and effort into effectively and efficiently running club operations.
- 6. Demonstrate proficient club leadership, including proper submission of paperwork and meeting the classification system of the Club Sport Program.
- 7. Have proper transition materials to help new club leadership function efficiently and effectively (returning clubs only).
- 8. Register their club on Presence.
- 9. Must have a faculty advisor. If you do not find/have one, JAX RecWell will provide one for you.
