The Jacksonville University Bachelor of Communication Sciences & Disorders prepares students to enter a growing and exciting new field of study and treatment. The bachelor's degree also offers the pre-professional education necessary to gain entry into graduate programs that are required to be licensed in the field.

With this degree you are able to:

1. Serve the community workforce as a professional aide in rehabilitation care
2. Work in a clinical field as a speech-language pathology assistant
 - a. Assist a Master's level clinician with treatment of children and adults
 - b. Provide assistance for program development of speech-language pathology
3. Enter in an accredited Master's degree program in speech language pathology or doctorate of audiology program.

The Jacksonville University, undergraduate major in Communication, Sciences and Disorders includes courses in language development, anatomy and physiology, neuroanatomy, acoustics and phonetics and other courses for professional preparation.

Admission Requirements:

- \$35 nonrefundable application fee
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Complete 60 credit hours of college coursework
- Complete Jacksonville University transfer undergraduate application
- An Associate of Arts degree from a regionally-accredited institution **OR** credit for the entire Jacksonville University undergraduate core curriculum
- Complete the following prerequisite courses with a grade of "C" or higher prior to enrollment in upper-division CSD courses:

• Human Anatomy & Physiology I	• Intro to Speech Disorders
• Human Anatomy & Physiology II	• Intro to Clinical Management
• A General Chemistry or Physics course (must include a lab)	• Biophysical Foundations in Health Sciences
• Human Nutrition or Human Growth & Development	• Socio-cultural Foundations in Health Sciences
• Statistics	• Intro to Psychology
