The Jacksonville University, undergraduate major in Communication, Sciences and Disorders includes courses in language development, anatomy and physiology, neuroanatomy, acoustics and phonetics and other courses for professional preparation.

Admission Requirements:

- \$35 nonrefundable application fee
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Complete 60 credit hours of college coursework
- Complete Jacksonville University transfer undergraduate application
- An Associate of Arts degree from a regionally-accredited institution <u>**OR**</u> credit for the entire Jacksonville University undergraduate core curriculum
- Complete the following prerequisite courses with a grade of "C" or higher prior to enrollment in upper-division CSD courses:
- Human Anatomy & Physiology I
- Human Anatomy & Physiology II
- A General Chemistry or Physics course (must include a lab)
- Human Nutrition or Human Growth & Development
- Statistics
